



I. Paragraph 6 – \_\_\_\_\_ - ***“For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever.”***

Paragraph 6 focuses exclusively on reverencing our sovereign, almighty God. This paragraph is solely about Him and it speaks to His character and works. In this paragraph, the believer acknowledges that God is the only true living God, creator of all things and ruler of all Creation. He is the King of the Kingdom of God and we are the citizens of His kingdom. The difference between Paragraph 1, Intimate Praise and Worship and this paragraph is our relationship to Him. In Paragraph 1, we address Him as Father because we are His children. In Paragraph 6, we are the citizens of His kingdom.

1. Worship God as a \_\_\_\_\_ of His Kingdom.

**Ephesians 2:19 NLT** – So now you Gentiles are longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God’s holy people. You are members of God’s family.

2. Take out Self (\_\_, \_\_, \_\_)

**John 4:26 NLT** – Then Jesus told her, “I am the Messiah!”

3. Declare the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ God.

- **Exodus 20:3-5 NLT**– “You must not have any other god but me. “You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children; the entire family is affected—even children in the third and fourth generations of those who reject me.
- **Psalms 93:3-5 NLT**– The floods have risen up, O Lord. The floods have roared like thunder; the floods have lifted their pounding waves. But mightier than the violent raging of the seas, mightier than the breakers on the shore—the Lord above is mightier than these! Your royal laws cannot be changed. Your reign, O Lord, is holy forever and ever.

- **Jude 1:25 NLT**– All glory to him who alone is God, our Savior through Jesus Christ our Lord. All glory, majesty, power, and authority are his before all time, and in the present, and beyond all time! Amen.
